The Eden Energy Medicine Regional Entry Program in Cleveland is a one-year program designed for people desiring in-depth coursework and supervision in Donna Eden's style of Energy Medicine (www.innersource.net). This program is based on a curriculum developed by Donna and her faculty members. The goal of the program is to help any student of Eden Energy Medicine obtain a firm foundation in the body of work Donna has created over the past 30 years and to develop the skills necessary to begin using these techniques regularly in life, either with oneself, family and friends, or in a professional practice.

The Regional Entry Program (REP) in Cleveland will be taught by Douglas Moore, Ph.D., one of the faculty members from the Two-Year Certification Program and the Coordinator of the One-Year Clinical Practicum. The main purpose of this program is educational and will include lecture, hands-on practice, as well as question and answer sessions. The program is designed to provide you with skills for working with the body's energies in order to promote physical and emotional well-being.

Energy Medicine classes can be an intense experience, and doing energy work in a large group can be taxing. If you are not in good health, we ask you to take this into account before registering. The program is a rigorous, large-group training event, and we ask you to set your expectations accordingly. If your primary need is in pursuing a healing experience, we encourage you to contact one of the trained practitioners listed on Donna Eden's website: (www.innersource.net/energy_medicine/practitioners_trained_em.htm) and work with him or her directly.

Successful completion of the Regional Entry Program in Cleveland will allow students to attend the second year of the Two-Year Eden Energy Medicine Certification Program (EEMCP), held in Phoenix, Arizona. Students may enter the EEMCP in Phoenix at any time during or at the end of the one-year Regional Entry Program. Completion of the one-year REP should not be construed as a certification in Eden Energy Medicine (EEM), as that requires the two-year program.

The registration procedures following this page are only for the Regional Entry Program in Cleveland.

When: Every quarter for one year. The four classes must be taken in sequence. Each of the preceding classes is a prerequisite for those afterwards. There are options available if you cannot make all the classes. These are listed under the Withdrawal Policy.

Tuition: \$3980.00 per year (\$995.00 per quarter). Meals and lodging are at the student's expense. The tuition payments can be paid quarterly, one month prior to each class. The tuition covers all of the class materials, conference space, faculty, and continued supervision by the teaching staff for the duration of the program. The cost of tuition is guaranteed for the current year. Please make checks payable to: Living-Now.

After attending a class, students may purchase a DVD of that class from Innersource to help facilitate their learning.

Wellness and Professional Tracks in the Certification Program: There are two tracks available in the Eden Energy Medicine Certification Program. The Wellness Track is for participants who wish to study Donna's body of work and practice only on themselves, family, and friends, rather than opening a practice or applying this work professionally. The Professional Track is intended for students who desire to apply the principles of EEM in a professional capacity and wish to be listed on Innersource's website. Students in both tracks attend the classes and complete open book written exams. Only the Professional Track students have to demonstrate specific methods learned during class. You need to indicate on this Registration Form if you want to complete the Wellness Track or the Professional Track.

Reading *Energy Medicine* by Donna Eden is important for either route.

Prerequisites: The following prerequisites apply to the Regional Entry Program and are required for both tracks. You may choose any one of the options below:

Option A: Attend an Eden Energy Medicine 5-Day Basic Training, taught by Donna Eden. This course is taught twice a year.

Option B* : Attend at least a 6 hour live class taught by Donna Eden and David Feinstein, Ph.D, plus complete and pass the online exam based on the Eden Energy Medicine 5-Day Basic Training DVD.

Option C* Attend an EEM Introductory Class taught by an authorized EEMCP faculty member, plus complete and pass the online exam based on the Eden Energy Medicine 5-Day Basic Training DVD.

* **Note:** If you are fulfilling prerequisites via *Option B* or *Option C*, you will be given until the start of Year 2 of the Certification Program (CP) to attend a live presentation by Donna Eden (*Option B*) or an EEM Introductory Class (*Option C*). This recognizes that these types of classes are offered intermittently and may not be easily accessible to you in a short period of time. However, you **MUST** complete and pass the online test associated with the 5-Day Basic Training DVD set before the start of REP Class 2.

When you register for Class 5 in Phoenix, you are required to attend the one day Review Class provided the day before CP classes begin. This review class covers all the material taught in the first year and is also an opportunity to practice giving a session. The tuition for this Review Class will be included in your tuition for Class 5.

Financial Aid: If you have financial hardships, there are a number of limited scholarships available when you start the program in Phoenix. If you need financial assistance for the Regional Program, we suggest you seek sponsors to support your training. You will be learning enough Energy Medicine to give sessions after the first class. Two sponsors who are willing to receive a weekly Eden Energy Medicine session at \$38/session will come close to covering your tuition. Both you and your sponsors will benefit greatly. The sponsor will be quite fortunate to have a weekly Energy Medicine session at a very reasonable cost, and you will get valuable practice.

Federal funds are available for *Laid Off or Terminated Workers* to be retrained.

Continuing Education: If you register for the EEMCP, Professional Track, CEU's will be provided during your second year of training in Phoenix.

CE providers include:

- Southern Oregon University

You will receive 259 hours of Nursing Continuing Education for your two-year training. The 259 hours include the REP, but those are only awarded once you complete the second year in Phoenix.

If you have any questions as to whether or not your professional continuing education requirements can be met through completion of this program, contact your professional licensing organization or state professions' bureau for a final decision.

Accommodations: Many hotels are within walking distance. They include the Holiday Inn, Embassy Suites, Red Roof Inn, and Sheraton to name a few. In addition to the hotels serving meals, there are a number of restaurants within walking distance and a list will be provided at the time of class.

Airport Information: Cleveland Hopkins International Airport is the closest airport and is about 15 minutes by taxi or shuttle to one of the above hotels. You are responsible for making your own transportation reservations. We know the Holiday Inn and Embassy Suites provide free shuttle service to and from the airport.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Prior to Class 1:

Students who withdraw from the program up to 60 days prior to the start of Class 1 will receive a full refund, less a \$25 administrative fee. For withdrawals between 30 and 60 days prior to the start of Class 1, \$200 will not be refunded. Due to limited space and other commitments we have to make well in advance in planning such events, no refunds can be made for withdrawals received within 30 days of the start of Class 1.

For withdrawals that occur from Class 2 forward:

If you withdraw from the program within thirty days before the start of that class, you will receive a 50% refund on any monies you have paid toward that particular class and a 100% of money for classes thereafter. If you just miss a class, but intend on completing the one-year program, you are still responsible for the full tuition for the class missed. Your tuition will still give you access to one of the teachers for questions on the material as well as handouts and continued participation in the Eden Energy Medicine Certification Program.

Withdrawals must be received in writing or by e-mail (doug@dougjmoore.com) and will be promptly acknowledged once received. In the case of emergencies (death or injury) or catastrophic (natural or accidental) events, you may contact Doug Moore and discuss your options.

MISSED CLASS POLICY

It is the students' responsibility to make up any work and instruction they miss if they fail to attend any of the four classes in this Regional Entry Program. Every effort will be made to work with you, including options such as review classes and private tutorials, at the student's expense. Students may also watch a DVD of a CP Class filmed in Phoenix. The purchase of the DVD is done through Innersource. You could also attend that EEMCP class in Phoenix or at another Regional Entry Program location. If you attend a class in Phoenix, you must complete the year in Phoenix- you will not be able to return to the Regional Entry Program.

RELEASE AGREEMENT

I understand that Eden Energy Medicine is an innovative approach to health care, which is only beginning to be investigated scientifically. I further understand that the training in Eden Energy Medicine and other services I am or may be receiving from Douglas Moore, Living-Now, and Innersource do not substitute for diagnosis and/or treatment from a qualified health practitioner for illnesses, injuries, or other medical conditions. Although the term Eden Energy Medicine uses the term "medicine" it is not to convey the practice of conventional medicine as legislated by the states. I understand that some classes are videotaped, that these tapes may be distributed for educational purposes, and I give my permission for my participation to appear on these tapes.

Douglas Moore, Living-Now, and Innersource reserve the right, at their discretion and without explanation, to ask a student to leave an Eden Energy Medicine Certification Program class, to terminate a student from the EEM Certification Program, or to not graduate a student from the EEM Certification Program based on failure to meet the academic, behavioral, professional, or ethical standards of the program as determined by Innersource staff. Any refunds will be fairly determined, again at the discretion of Innersource staff, on a case-by-case basis.

Eden Energy Medicine Wellness and Professional Track Addendum

WELLNESS TRACK

Audience:

Participants who wish to study Donna's body of work and practice only on themselves, family, and friends. They do not intend to open a practice, to practice this work professionally, or to be listed on the website.

Learning format:

During class: The students will participate in all lectures, demonstrations and practice sessions, like the Professional Track.

After each class: Students will be expected to submit the same written tests as the Professional Track. The main difference is that they will not do a demonstration at the end of each class, as the Professional Track is required to do. The students will have two hours of supervision time with a faculty member: one hour to have their written test reviewed and graded, and one hour for learning support via email, if they choose to use it.

At the end of the two years: As part of their tuition, students will have the right to schedule a two-hour consulting session with a faculty member to ask questions and review the material that was covered in the program. They will have 3 months to schedule this session after the end of the last class, Class 8. Once students have successfully completed the 8 classes, they will receive a Diploma which will be their record of having successfully graduated from the Eden Energy Medicine Two-Year Certification Program, Wellness Track.

Switching from the EEMCP Wellness Track to the EEMCP Professional Track:

Students may switch from the Wellness Track to the Professional Track at any time **during the first year of class**. To do this, students must schedule a demo out session with a faculty member to demonstrate their practical knowledge of the techniques that have been covered in the classes they have taken. If, for example, a student that registered for the Wellness Track decides to move to the Professional Track after completing Class 3, the student will then inform Innersource of this interest in writing and will schedule a session with a EEMCP faculty member to demonstrate practical proficiency in the material taught in Classes 1, 2, and 3. This session may last 2- 3 hours, depending on when they choose to switch. Students will have to cover this expense. Students will have until the end of March, after the end of their first year, Class 4, to switch.

If the student decides to switch during the second year or after completing the two years, he or she will be required to repeat Year 2. The goal is to make sure the student attends the class with the intention of learning the material for professional purposes. The price to attend repeating Year 2 will be one-half the cost of tuition per class. During this year, the student will be required to submit all written tests and demos after each class. Once all the requirements for Year 2 are completed, the student will be able to complete the graduation session and apply to be listed on the website.

Scholarships for the EEMCP Wellness Track:

Since the scholarship funds are limited, there will not be scholarships offered to students who enroll in this track. Students that need scholarship support for their studies are encouraged to consider enrolling in the EEM Professional Track.

Continuing Education for the EEMCP Wellness Track:

CEU's will not be available for the Wellness Track.

EEMCP Diploma:

This Diploma is your record of having successfully graduated from the Eden Energy Medicine Two-Year Certification Program. Your Diploma remains valid forever as evidence of your graduation. You do not have to renew it.

EEMCP Certificate:

Students who graduated from the Wellness Track will not receive a certificate since their training was primarily for use with themselves, family, and friends and not intended to be used for professional application.

PROFESSIONAL TRACK

Audience: Students who wish to practice Eden Energy Medicine in a professional setting.

Learning Format:

During Class: EEMCP Professional Track students will participate in all lectures, demonstrations and practice sessions.

After each class: EEMCP Professional Track students are required to submit a written test and complete a demonstration after each class. Students who submit their written test and fail to do their demo on time will be offered the EEMCP Wellness Track as an alternative.

Students have two options to do their demos:

1. Present their demo to their supervising faculty member using Skype. Students need a computer with a video camera so that the teacher can watch the demonstration remotely. It is similar to a live demo in many ways.
2. Present their demo in a live session with a faculty member.

Options 1 and 2 do not require an additional expense for the student (aside from computer accessories).

There is a third option of submitting DVDs of the demonstration, but this is only available for students attending classes in Phoenix. Also, once in Phoenix, if students choose to do a live demo with a faculty member who is not their supervising teacher for that class, they will have to pay the faculty member for the private demonstration session. There is no additional expense for the student if the live demonstration is done with the assigned supervising faculty for that class.

At the end of the two years: Students are required to present a two-hour graduation session, which is covered by their tuition. After graduation all students will receive a diploma, and graduates of the Professional Track will also receive a certificate.

EEMCP Diploma:

This Diploma is your record of having successfully graduated from the Eden Energy Medicine Two-Year Certification Program. Your Diploma remains valid forever as evidence of your graduation. You do not have to renew it.

EEMCP Certificate:

The certificate will designate which EEM title you may use for presenting yourself to the public as certified in Eden Energy Medicine. Students who graduated from the Wellness Track will not receive a certificate since their training was primarily for use with themselves, family, and friends and not intended to be used for professional application.

The title you may use is: **Eden Energy Medicine Certified Practitioner, Two-Year Graduate**, which is abbreviated as: **EEM-CP**

The certificate will have an issue and renewal date. You will be able to continue using the title and be listed on the web site as long as you are in good standing with your EEM Continued Training and have maintained other requirements such as legal and ethical standards. One of those requirements is to have appropriate professional liability insurance that lists Innersource as an "Additional Insured Endorsement". Your certification will need to be renewed every two years from your issue date by completing 12 hours of Continued Training (CT) in an approved Eden Energy Medicine program.

Please remember...these requirements are necessary if you want to stay listed on the Innersource website, use the title Eden Energy Medicine Certified Practitioner and present yourself to the public as certified in EEM.

Switching from the EEMCP Professional Track to the EEMCP Wellness Track:

Students may switch from the Professional Track to the Wellness Track at any time during the two-year program. They need to inform Innersource in writing of their interest in switching tracks. Students must have completed the written test requirements of the last class they have taken to continue with the Wellness Track.
